Teams must participate in ALL Four venues to join the Circuit

How does the NW Challenge Circuit Race work?

1. Each team pays a \$75.00 fee to join the Circuit.
2. Each team must pay all necessary fees to enter each of the participating races.
3. The NW Challenge Circuit will accumulate the team's "fastest" time from each of the participating races.
4. There will be two divisions (Mixed and Women's) with A and B subdivisions (subject to change depending on Circuit enrollment).
5. Medals will be given to participating teams finishing 1st through 3rd in their respective divisions (Mixed A and B and Women's A and B).
